GENERAL DIVISI INSTRUCTIONS for MIDDLE SCHOOL MIXED:

Middle School Mixed auditions on S, A, T, or B. When any part (S, A, T, or B) divides so that a choice must be made about which note a student should sing, use the following as a rule:

- Districts V VII sing the upper note
- Districts I IV sing the lower note

EXAMPLE: If there are 2 notes for the sopranos, District V-VII Soprano would sing the higher note, District I-IV Soprano would sing the lower note.

Middle School Mixed DOES NOT audition on S1, S2, A1, A2, etc., so please use the rules above as a guide for which note the students should sing.
